About this job

As a student psychologist at Breda University of Applied Sciences, you will work with young adults during their development into young professionals. You will be conducting intake interviews and provide short treatment programmes to students who have applied for psychological help or have been referred by a student counsellor. You have and maintain contact with referral partners, so that you can refer students when longer-term or other support is required. By promoting our services and by offering easily accessible group therapy sessions, we prevent psychosocial problems from getting in the way of the students' development. Furthermore, it helps to timely identify students who are about to fall behind in their study progress. You will develop and give the group therapy sessions together with your student psychologist colleague on topics such as autonomy, self-image, social anxiety and/or fear of failure. You will also work on expanding and strengthening cooperation with colleagues who work closely together with students, such as coaches, student counsellors and, of course, lecturers. You will also offer these colleagues masterclasses to help increase their expertise in dealing with students with psychosocial problems or identifying them.

This position is a temporary replacement (for one-year) due to illness.

What do we offer?

- You get the opportunity to work with young adults within an international academic environment;
- You will work together with an experienced student psychologist, allowing you to gain a lot of experience in a short period of time;
- You will receive almost eleven weeks of holiday entitlements in a full-time position;
- You will be working on a green, sustainable campus near the city centre of Breda;
- Your commuting expenses will be fully reimbursed when you travel by public transport;
- You will receive compensation for health insurance;
- You will be awarded professional development hours every year;

The salary for this position amounts to a monthly minimum of € 3,881.09 and a maximum of € 5,332.48 (gross amounts based on full-time employment);

The position is valued in scale 11 of the CAO HBO (Dutch collective labour agreement);

What do we ask of you?

- You are in possession of a BIG registration;
- You have at least two years of experience in providing psychological treatments, and are able to carry out independent treatment;
- Because you know that there are no one-size-fits-all approaches in working with people, you adopt a flexible attitude;
- You dare to speak your mind and are a valuable discussion partner for your colleagues;
- You understand that preventing and managing mental health issues among students is a joint responsibility and therefore seek strong cooperation with student coaches, student counsellors and lecturers;
- You will be working in an international and intercultural setting. Therefore, having excellent verbal and written communication skills in English is a necessity. BUAs provides guidance for improving your English language proficiency.
